Results have been sent to EA so should be published soon.Overall positive feedback from those attending.  Round the lake - race open for 15 + giving team prizes of bottles of wine and there were juniors in this winning team. Poole keen not to hold round the lakes twice in a year. 3. Feedback from discussions with EA	Personal liability discussion with EA. Thank you Mike for taking forward discussion. EA believes there to be a misunderstanding between RD's and EA - there has been no changes in public liability and requirements for running races. RD's are treated as club officials. Separate policy for this.	Arrange for Barry Hopkins from England Athletics to meet with members of DRRL committee and RD's again to clarify EA position, this is especially for those that have subsequently cancelled races as a result of the first meeting. Mike has agreed to arrange.	
4. Should the DRRL "rules" be changed to allow selection of league races outside Dorset?	8 clubs voted yes. 1 club voted against. General consensus was that this would be ok as long as sensible precautions were taken, including a race of a 'good distance' and not miles into the neighbouring counties.		
5. Should the DRRL accept races from Club s using ARC to licence their events	7 Clubs voted yes and 1 club voted no. Therefore ARC races can be used in DRRL but this should be kept the least amount possible.

Boscombe 5km- Mike suggested they would be happy to be a stand by race.  We have also put in Egdon Easy as a standby race as we did not have enough information to include it and it was felt that we had managed to create a league with EA affiliated races.  We did not have enough information on Portland 10km or round the rock regarding its intention to run and therefore was not included in the list.
