2. Feed back from past DRRL races. Boscombe 10k and Broadstone Quarter	<b>Boscombe 10k</b> – Very good, all went well. 	club runners were the ones wearing headphones. A discussion was held around whether a reminder could be put on the race numbers, but uncertainty around how effective this might be.		
3. County Champs – Increasing awareness	There is a declining participation in Dorset County Athletics and Team Dorset events, with Roger highlighting a 23% decrease in participants year over year. The group discussed the Dorset County Championships, where it was suggested reversing the eligibility process by assuming all participants are eligible unless they opt out, though Jerry noted this would still require verifying eligibility criteria. The discussion concluded with Mike proposing to work with race timing companies to announce county championship winners on race days, and the group agreed to explore this option further, particularly given the significant investment in medals for the next 3-4 years.
